During my 5 years as a Consultant Surgeon in Arthroplasty and Reconstructive Surgery at the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery, I gained experience in complex primary and revision hip- and knee replacement surgery, and developed an interest in arthroscopic shoulder, knee and ligament reconstruction surgery, and was fortunate to be nominated for the SAOA German Fellowship in Knee- and Sports Surgery at various leading centres in Germany, including the prestigious ATOS Klinik in Heidelberg.

I have been in a full time private practice at Worcester MediClinic since 2014, and have recently expanded my services to Carewell Hospital in Robertson, for day surgery procedures and consultations.
